SUMMARY

During my senior year of my undergraduate studies, I began working on my Honors thesis under the direction of Dr. Augustine Osman. For my research, I am seeking to examine behavioral issues between male and female students in school; to do this, the Minnesota Multiphasic Personality Inventory for Adolescents (MMPI-A) is my assessment of choice. The MMPI-A aids clinicians in assessing a range of specific psychological disorders, personal, social, and behavioral concerns for individuals between the ages of fourteen and eighteen. This study uses archival data and provides detailed descriptive information about the clinical and content scale profiles for a sample of adolescent psychiatric inpatients. T-scores will be used to interpret profile descriptions and assess the behaviors potentially resulting in lower school performance.
